

# How to View Your eLearning on Your iPad

Easy, Step-by-Step Instructions

## DOWNLOADING THE ARTICULATE MOBILE PLAYER

The steps on this page show you how to download the Articulate Mobile Player, which is the recommended way to view your eLearning content on your iPad. It's a free, quick download from the iTunes App Store, and you only need to download it once.

On your iPad, tap the **App Store** icon.



In the Search window, type **Articulate Mobile Player**. Once you see it listed, tap that item to select it.



Tap the **Install** button for the Articulate Mobile Player.



If prompted, enter your **Apple ID** and tap **OK**.



When the installation is done, you'll see the Articulate icon on your iPad screen (remember that you can swipe left to see any other iPad screens you've created.)




## DOWNLOADING AND LAUNCHING YOUR COURSE

Once you have the Articulate Mobile Player installed on your iPad, follow these steps any time you want to launch one of your eLearning courses.

**Tap** the Articulate icon on your iPad to open the Articulate Mobile Player.



The first time you open the Player (or any time you don't have any content in your Library), you will see the Help screen that shows you basic information about how to use the Player. Take a moment to review it, and note that you will have the option to download some courses to review them offline on your iPad. (Instructions for deleting it afterward are below.)




Tap your iPad's **Home** button to return to your main iPad screen.




If the course link is on a web page, simply open your Safari browser, go to the page, and tap the link to launch the course. Or you can open your iPad's Safari web browser, type in the URL, and press Enter on your keyboard.



If you were sent the course link via e-mail, open your iPad's e-mail app by tapping its **Mail** icon, and then tap the course link in the e-mail message.




The course launch page will appear in your iPad's Safari browser. Tap the **Launch** button to load the course into your Mobile Player app.



The course will open automatically in the Player (rather than your Safari browser, which would not render the course content as smoothly).


You can now take your course online from your iPad using the Player. The experience will be virtually identical to taking it on a computer, except that you will not see rewind or mute buttons or some menu options. We recommend that you always listen to any audio included. If you need to adjust the volume, you can use the buttons on the side of your iPad.




If you'd like to save your course to your iPad so that you can view it *offline* at your convenience, tap the **Library** button in the upper right corner of the Player frame. It's a great way to view the course while commuting via train/subway (with earphones!).



On the Player's main Library screen, locate the "Available Offline:" slider in the upper right corner of the frame, and use your finger to slide the gray square over the "No" to reveal the green "Yes" instead.




The course will now download to your iPad for offline viewing. Once the message reads "Download Complete" you can tap the **Continue** button to view the course offline.



TIP: If at any point you are notified that the course has been updated, you can move the slider back to show "No" and then back to "Yes" again while connected to the internet or network, and the latest version of the course will download as long as you're connected to the internet.

Once you've downloaded a course for offline viewing, from the Player's home page, tap the course name on the left menu to highlight it, then tap the **Play** button to start the course.



If you aren't able to finish the course in one sitting, no problem. The next time you open the Mobile Player, you'll see a prompt asking whether you'd like to resume where you left off. Tap "Yes" to resume, or "No" to return to the beginning of the course.



To delete a course from your Player Library (and from your iPad), simply use your finger to left-swipe the menu item, and then tap the **Delete** button that appears next to the item you wish to remove. You can download the course again at a later date, if needed, provided the link is still available.
